Five Ways to Prepare for Mass

Let the words penetrate your mind and your soul. How do these readings apply to your life? What is the Lord saying to you in these readings? Is there something that you are being asked to do? Is the Lord leading you in a new direction?

Finding the weekly readings is easy. You can purchase a Sunday Missal, subscribe to a magazine like My Daily Visitor, Magnificat, or The Word Among Us. You can also check out readings in many online sources, among them www.usccb.org.

As you become accustomed to reviewing the readings ahead of time, you will begin to look forward to going to Mass. During the Mass vou will have a deeper awareness of how the introductory prayers tie into the theme of the readings. When you hear the readings proclaimed and listen as the priest gives the homily, the insights you receive will be more profound, and you will have a heightened spiritual awareness.
