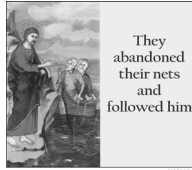

## **WHAT DOES THE ARCHDIOCESAN CORPORATION REORGANIZATION FILING MEAN FOR OUR PARISH?:**

As you likely know, the Archdiocese of St. Paul and Minneapolis corporation filed for Chapter 11 Reorganization on Friday, January 16. Our parish is not included in this filing. All parishes in the archdiocese have been separately incorporated under a religious corporation statute dating back to the 1800s. The ministries of our parish will continue. Parents should have no concerns about registering their children for Catholic school, faith formation, and sacramental preparation programs, they will continue as scheduled. The many other ministries of our parish will go forward as usual.
