## Five Ways to Prepare for Mass

### 5. Enter into God's presence.

Spend some time in silence before Mass begins. Quiet your mind. Let go of any tensions or anxieties that you brought with you.

Think about how you purposely avoided food for an hour before Mass. One reason for this fast was to create in you a feeling of hunger for the Eucharist. Allow your soul to yearn for the Lord. Ask God to fill all of the empty places inside you.

Invite the Holy Spirit to speak to you in the readings, the music, the homily, the prayers of the Mass, and your Communion in Prior Lake. For info, meditation. Everything that you think and do in these final moments before Mass instills in you a joyful anticipation for your encounter with the Lord.

When you take the time to prepare for Mass, your attitude begins to change. The Mass becomes much more than something Mother of the Church in that you do every weekend. Your mind discovers a deeper appreciation of the mystery that you experience during the liturgy, your heart becomes more open to God's love, and your soul becomes more receptive to the graces that God is bestowing upon you.
