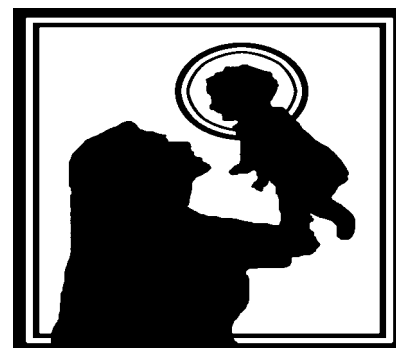

ADD A LITTLE EXTRA

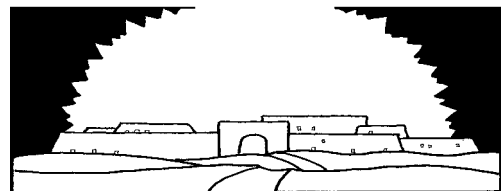
