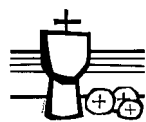

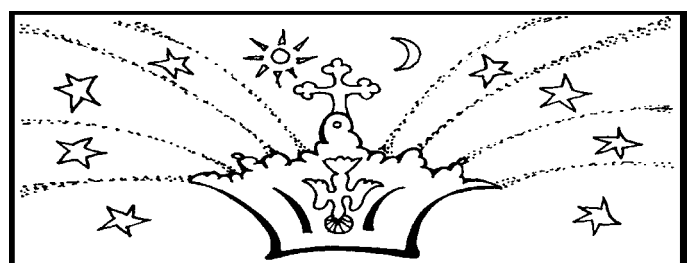
ST. CATHERINE'S AUTUMN DINNER:
