## FROM THE PASTOR

### The Church of St. Patrick, Cedar Lake

Our church of St. Patrick is one of the 4 oldest churches in the Archdiocese. The original log church was built in 1857-1858. In 1870 or 1871 the current stone sanctuary was built at the end of the log church and the cornerstone for the main body of the church was laid in November, 1873, and was completed the following year. It was dedicated on October 11, 1874 by Bishop Thomas L. Grace, the anniversary of which we are celebrating today.



The interior of the church was completely renovated in 2005 which included the building of the new altars. This is why visitors are surprised when I tell them how old it is; it looks and feels new. The latest addition was the new tabernacle and stand behind the altar which was completed in May.

In the prayers on the anniversary of the dedication of a church we pray, "O God, who year by year renew for us the day when this your holy temple was consecrated, hear the prayers of your people and grant that in this place for you there may always be pure worship and for us, fullness of redemption."

Think of how many prayers, Masses, baptisms, weddings, and funerals have happened in this church for the past 146 years! As the preface for the anniversary Mass says, "For in this visible house that you have let us build and where you never cease to show your favor to the family on pilgrimage to you in this place, you wonderfully manifest and accomplish the mystery of your communion with us."

A church is also an image of our own soul in which God's presence dwells. In the final blessing of the anniversary Mass the priest prays, "And may He, who has willed that all His scattered children be gathered together in His Son, grant that you may become His temple and the dwelling place of the Holy Spirit. Thus, may you be made thoroughly clean, so that God may dwell within you and you may possess with all the Saints the inheritance of eternal happiness." Amen.
