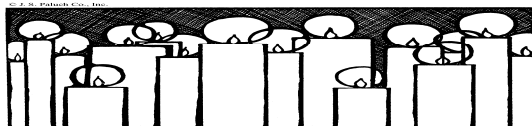

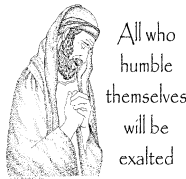
**MEETING:** Monday, October 28th at 7:00 PM.
