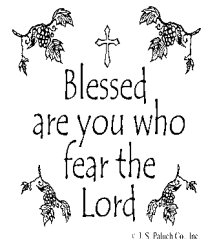

3. Watch Your Expectations. Sometimes people have unrealistic expectations of what a priest "should be" or "should do". They want Father to be present at every parish function, every community event, and every time someone has a question, concern, or special need.

It's important to remember that priests are people, too, with the same normal human limits. Just as you need a day or two off every week, so does your priest. In fact, studies have shown that time off is important for priests, to help them maintain both their spiritual focus and their energy levels. One priest recognized that after concerned parishioners insisted that he take a day off each week, he was actually able to accomplish *more*. We can all forget to take care of ourselves now and then; it doesn't hurt to remind your priest to do so.

Accept your priest for the unique person he is. Priests come in all shapes, sizes, ages, and personality styles: introverts and extroverts; mild-mannered and quick-tempered; serious and witty. Each priest has his own preferences and peculiarities as well, so let him be himself, with his own gifts and talents. Each priest will minister in his own way. Trust God to work through your priest to meet the needs of the parish, and let him know that you support him. If you have the ability to make your priest laugh—do it! A good laugh goes a long way toward relieving any stress he may be feeling. *To be continued . . .*
