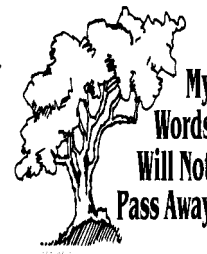

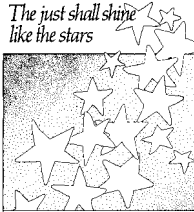
ST. CATHERINE C.C.W. CHRISTMAS LUNCHEON:
