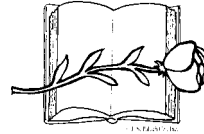

Dear Rosie and the St. Patrick / St. Catherine Volunteers,

We would like to extend a heartfelt thank you for your recent donation of time and talents on Saturday, November 4th, to benefit Bridging families. We are truly grateful for your support of the mission through warehouse assistance and shopping assistance. Your generous in-kind donation of time allows us to adequately serve the community needs and meet our goal of serving over 4,000 households in 2006.

One hundred families visit Bridging each week to obtain necessary items to help them rebuild their lives, this number will grow to 130 families this fall with our expansion plans to Roseville. Bridging provides the items to turn empty houses into a comfortable place to perform the basic necessities of life, a bed to sleep in, a table to eat at, and a dresser to put their clothes in. Each week twenty semi-loads of furniture leaves our warehouse for their new homes.

Bridging opened a third location in November to better serve the Twin Cities. This new facility, 1635 Terrace Drive in Roseville, is just one mile north of Rosedale Center. We now need your donations of household goods, furniture, and volunteer talents in three Minnesota locations. Help spread the word and stock the shelves!
