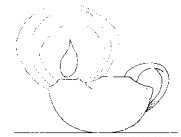

**EFFECTIVE PLANNING**

Short term planning is easier and less time consuming, but planning for the long term can be beneficial, too. Effective *estate planning* **now** can benefit you, your heirs, charity, and help to avoid difficulties that can arise when an estate is not properly planned.

First and foremost, as a good steward, you must make sure that you have a valid and up to date Christian Will.

America dies without a will? Many people spend lifetimes building up their estates and accumulating property but fail to develop a plan to distribute their worldly blessings.

If you die without a valid will, the state in which you reside has a predetermined formula for the court to distribute the assets of your estate to your heirs regardless of your intent or relationship with them.

A valid will allows your loved ones to participate in honoring your intentions rather than being subjected to the directives of the court. A valid will can also save your estate expenses. For instance, an invalid will might require a bond to be established for those handling the estate. That cost would have to be paid by the estate thus incurring an additional expense against the proceeds of the estate.

Providing for children, grandchildren, other dependents and for charity are all part of effective *estate planning* that will honor your wishes and directives to take care of the people and institutions you care about most.

A periodic review of your estate plan, particularly, if your goals have changed or loved ones have predeceased you can provide great comfort to you in knowing that thoughtful provisions have been made reflecting your wishes and priorities. A *periodic review* can also help to avert problems for your heirs who will live with the directives of your estate plan.
