GIVE GOD A DIME FIRST THEN SPEND THE REST

This is a story about a pastor who made it a practice to address the children in his congregation on some special topic, along with his regular Sunday morning sermon. There was a good attendance of children at the morning hour of worship, so the pastor always gave special preparation to his topic for the children.

Each week he would encourage the children to answer his questions and interject with their own thoughts. One morning he presented the subject of making a budget. His theme was on the careful handling of money. To help develop this theme he had a dollar in change. He counted out the dollar before the children then raised the question: "Suppose a dollar were given to you each week by your parents as your allowance, and you could have no more; how would you use it? There was a silence for a moment, and then children one by one began to give their suggestions. One thought some of the dollar could be spent on pencils and paper for school. Others interjected with amounts for candy, pop, and ice cream. One boy contributed the idea of saving some of the dollar through the local grade school savings plan. By this time the entire dollar was used up, so the pastor then raised the questions:

Where does the Church come in? What have we left for Sunday School? How does God figure into our budget?

After a short silence, one lad spoke up. "We started wrong," he said. "Let's give God a dime first, and then spend the rest." So a dime was budgeted for God and the remaining ninety cents was spent with the greatest enthusiasm, and no small amount of wisdom.

This story is a good example to follow our own budgeting. rest with great enthusiasm.

A dime out of every dollar for God? If you haven't tried it, you haven't discovered the real fun of spending the other ninety cents.
