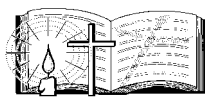

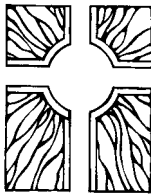
A CORDIAL WELCOME TO ALL: If you are a visitor you are invited to sign the welcome book in the entry way and come and worship with us again.

A DAY OF RICHES

The spiritual and pastoral riches of Sunday, as it

has been handed on to us by tradition are truly great. When its significance and implications are understood in their entirety, Sunday in a way becomes a synthesis of the Christian life and a condition for living it well. It is clear therefore why the observance of the Lord's Day is so close to the Church's heart.

WORDS TO LIVE BY

And so we close this little exercise of coming to understand, appreciate, and commit ourselves to living the Christian life with Sunday at its center. Let us remember that this is more than an obligation imposed on us by the Church. It is a crucial aspect of being fully human, which is why we work to be sure all people have the right and ability to celebrate the Lord's day.

Even when the culture in which we live tempts us with busyness and work; even when our own greed or compulsion to work tempts us to skip Sunday rest, the Church invites us to remain strong. Even if we are tempted to ignore the plight of the poor, or keep them on the margins of life, God gives us Sundays for communal love and caring.

Understood in this way, Sunday becomes a wellspring of hope for the soul, a healing balm, a time of peace and rest. Gathering for liturgy, sharing meals afterward, and resting from work all become the stuff from which our spiritual lives are nourished.
