We pray together in the words that Jesus taught us, the Our Father. Then, we share a spiritual meal in communion with one another. We experience the Real Presence of Jesus. We give thanks for all of the good things that the Lord has done for us.

At the end of the Mass, we are sent into the world to love and serve the Lord and one another.
