WHAT IS YOUR LIFE SAYING?

The Bible says not to worry about what we will eat or drink or how we will clothe ourselves (Mt.6:31). But this verse is not just about worry. It's about focus. You see, when we're focused on what we believe we don't have, we wrongly believe we have nothing to give. Our focus is on ourselves.

Matthew 6:33 goes on to say, "But seek first the Kingdom of God and all these things will be yours as well." God wants to bless us. God also wants to use us to bless others. When we focus on ourselves, we don't feel joy in giving, nor do we even feel inclined to give. When our focus is on God, we trust that God will meet our every need, which frees us to give our time, abilities, and money in service to others.

If you're finding yourself being stingy with what God has given you, ask yourself where your focus has been. When you're caught up in the things that matter most to God, such as loving others, showing mercy, praying for your enemies, and being a blessing to others, you don't even have to ask the question. Your life will say it all.
