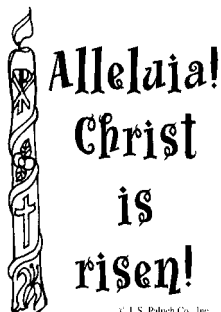

### COMMUNION & SIGN OF PEACE DURING FLU SEASON

1. If you or a person next to you prefers not to shake hands, a suitable gesture such as a nod of the head and a verbal gesture of peace would be fitting.
2. It is recommended that you replace the handshake with another suitable gesture if you are ill.
3. If you are sick with a cold or flu, do not receive from the cup.
4. Extraordinary ministers of the Eucharist should wash their hands before mass.

### STEWARDSHIP CHARACTERISTICS

Christian stewardship takes a positive view on money. It sees money not only as a medium of exchange, but a symbol of the person who has it. The way we acquire it, use it, and share it, are revealed in those actions.
