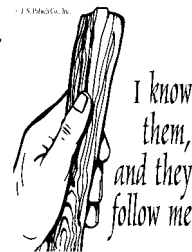

**4th Sunday of Easter, April 29**

Paul and Barnabas knew victory, and they also knew defeat. Sometimes whole cities gathered to hear the word of God they proclaimed. Other times, people turned against them. Filled with the joy of the Spirit, the apostles refused to listen to the voice of discouragement. Instead, they obeyed the voice of the Lord: “I have made you a light to all nations, a means of salvation to the ends of the earth!”

John was lifted from gloom of Patmos when he envisioned a throng of martyrs from “every nation and race, people, and tongue” dressed in their white baptismal garments and waving palm branches of victory. Never again would they suffer and mourn, hunger or thirst, for the Lamb was their shepherd who would lead them to life-giving water.

Jesus’ followers would not always be shielded from adversity, but he would be with his flock to guide and protect them. They were given to his care by God the Father, and no one could snatch them away. “We are his people, the flock that he tends,” the psalmist rejoiced in God’s faithfulness, which endures to all generations. **For Reflection:** Am I able to hold fast to God’s grace in times of misfortune as well as in times of good fortune?
