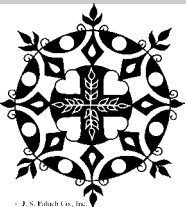

GOD GAVE HIM A CARING HEART

Before Manute Bol was badly injured in an automobile accident, he was one of the tallest basketball players in the NBA. Standing near a basket, he could stretch his 7'7" frame and block shots before they headed downward toward the hoop. In one game he simply reached up and swatted the ball away from the basket eleven times in the first half.

Unfortunately, he had so many injuries that he was compelled to give up the sport and to focus on getting as whole as he possibly could. He had played with such teams as the Washington Bullets, the Golden State Warriors, and the Miami Heat.

When he had a salary coming in, he became known as a generous giver to those suffering in his homeland known as the Sudan. There were thousands in refugee camps there due to a civil war between Christian rebels and a repressive Islamic government. The conflict made many people homeless and left many children orphans.

Manute sent most of his salary to those suffering the most. An American sports writer once asked the lanky athlete why he sent so much money to help those afflicted in his homeland. The gently man answered, "God guided me to America and gave me a good job. But he also gave me a heart so I would look back."

I find that a challenging quote. It prompts me to ask: Has not God guided me also and allowed me to have a wonderful life in this blessed nation? But what about my heart? Is it uncaring, selfish, and turned inward toward self-satisfaction? Or is my heart opened outward in love and caring service toward those who are so desperate that they cannot help themselves?

And I also ask myself, "What about my support for God's Church. Did I not promise to support it with my prayers, my presence, and my gifts?" How likely is God's work on earth going to get done unless I do my share?
