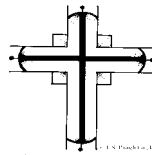

WAYS TO GIVE

The saying, “charity begins at home,” is not found in the Bible, but it does make a point. We should help those in need, beginning with those closest to us: our family, our relatives, our neighbors. It may be easier to help the anonymous poor of Ethiopia than a relative who can’t manage money, but both the Old and New Testaments agree that our generosity should begin with those we are bound to in one way or another.

The difficulty with the saying “charity begins at home” is that it is often used to justify charity ending there. The idea is something Scripture does not teach. On the contrary, our acts of charity are to ripple ever farther out to the needs of the world.
