**MISSION APPEAL:** St. Vincent and the Grenadines is a multi-island country in the lower Eastern Caribbean. It has a population of about 110,000 of whom about 10,000 are Catholic. Bishop Robert Rivas O.P. is Bishop of Kingstown, the capital of St. Vincent. The Diocese of Kingstown was formed on January 22, 1990. Fr. Pio Atonio, M.F. (Missionaries of Faith) is a native of Samoa. He has been a priest for fourteen years and has served the last ten as a missionary in St. Vincent and the Grenadines in the Diocese of Kingstown. He is currently the parish priest at St. John the Evangelist Parish in Mesopotamia in central St. Vincent. Next weekend, May 21 & 22, we will have a second collection for this mission appeal.

At dawn, I greet another completely new day. It too is begun in the name of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. As this continues day after day, I remember the psalmist who prayed to God, "You are great and do wondrous things; you alone are God!"
