### TEN THINGS THAT MAKE FOR A GREAT CATHOLIC DAD:

**2. Teach Your Children Faith (John 20:29).** If we want our children to have faith in God, we'll teach them to believe in things they cannot experience with their five natural senses. Talking about molecules, or germs, or black holes is a good start. We all accept that there are everyday realities we'll never see firsthand, but that are real. This is, of course, the foundation for teaching them *our* Faith. We need to nurture our own Faith, of course, in order to be able to teach it—whether that means regular prayer and Scripture study, spiritual reading, or active involvement in our churches. Faith is learned best by example, and it requires genuine belief. It requires surrender. And the single best way to raise children who have unshakable faith in God is to teach them that there are things they can trust and believe in unconditionally—like their dads.
