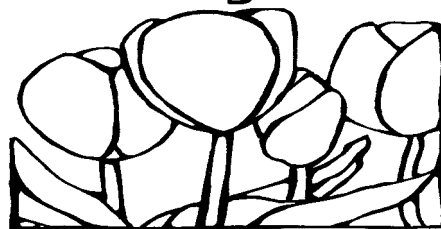

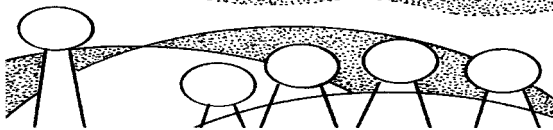

5th Sunday of Easter, May 6

As Paul and Barnabas proclaimed the good news on their missionary journey, they discovered that, though many doors were closed to their preaching, others were wide open. John's vision on the isle of Patmos was like an open door to heaven. All the threats and perils of the present world vanished as a renewed world came forth.
