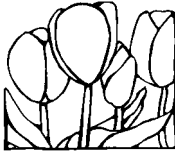

**PARISH NURSE PROGRAM:** Osteoporosis is the loss of bone density that can begin in early 40's. How much density lost depends on your diet and exercise. Once the bones lose calcium the bones can become brittle and break easily. If you have osteoporosis, physical therapists suggest to do strengthening exercises: walking, bicycling, and light swimming. Good nutrition, calcium, estrogen supplements (natural & prescribed), and weight bearing exercise may prevent this problem from happening to you.
