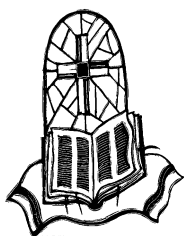

PRO-LIFE CORNER

A general practitioner has been censured by the Swedish health authorities, after saying no to an abortion. In 2010, a woman went to the doctor, asking for an abortion. The doctor reportedly began to have second thoughts after the woman's husband asked the day before the scheduled abortion if there were any alternatives. The doctor cancelled the abortion appointment, saying the woman "didn't seem to be mentally balanced and in a condition to make well-reasoned decisions." The National Board of Health and Welfare (NBHW) told the physician that her only task is to carry out the wishes of the patient, regardless of her estimation of the patient's mental state. The incident occurred one year after Swedish parliamentarians voted against accepting a resolution of the Parliamentary Assembly of the Council of Europe supporting conscience rights for doctors across the European Union. Since 1973 law doctors can be jailed in Sweden for refusing to participate in abortion. Sweden has one of the oldest abortion laws in Europe, having allowed abortion legally since 1938 for eugenic reasons. The law was expanded in 1946 to include socio-medical grounds and since 1974 abortion is allowed for any or no reason on request up to the 18th week of pregnancy.
