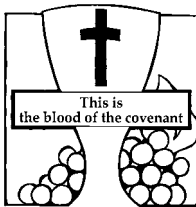

TEN THINGS THAT MAKE FOR A GREAT CATHOLIC DAD:

4. Give and Let Give (Proverbs 28:27).
 An old expression advises, “When there’s a piano to be moved, don’t reach for the stool.” Generosity certainly isn’t a value unique to Catholicism. But making it a non-negotiable part of our families’ lives—no matter what our circumstances—is a part of our Faith. Again, this is behavior we as dads can and must model if we expect our children to learn compassion. Let your kids put the envelope in the church collection basket on Sunday. When family, friends, or charitable organizations ask for your help, identify what you enjoy or what you’re best at and pitch in. Let your children see you giving, and talk with them about why you give and why giving is important. *To be continued . . .*
