FROM THE PASTOR

Introducing Father John Hayes



Last Saturday, June 6, our Teaching Parish seminarian Deacon John Hayes was ordained to the order of the priesthood by Bishop John LeVoir in the Cathedral of the Holy Trinity in New Ulm. Fr. Hayes has been with our parish for the past four years as part of his training and formation as a seminarian at the St. Paul Seminary in St. Paul. It has been a joy having him with us and walking with him through the various stages of his formation. I am grateful to the members of his Teaching Parish Committee that provided him with support and feedback independently of me. It is very unfortunate that we could not experience his final semester of parish ministry as a deacon because of the restrictions brought on by Covid-19.

Thanks to Archbishop Hebda taking my Masses at our parishes (his first visit to both) I was able to concelebrate Fr. John's first Mass the next day. It was satisfying to me that I was the oldest priest in the sanctuary by at least 15 years. That means the Church is quite alive as God is calling young men to the priesthood. Fr. Hayes gave me the privilege of delivering the homily. As it was the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, my starting point was the first point of Bishop LeVoir at the ordination, that a priest's first duty is to offer worship to God. There could not have been a better connection of place and time, as we were in a cathedral dedicated to the Most Holy Trinity on its very Solemnity, to which all worship is directed. I also encouraged Fr. John, and all of us, to stay close to the Blessed Virgin Mary; because if we are close to her, we are close to Jesus. All of us must correct our fellow Christians that accuse us of worshipping Mary that we do not. Mary worships the Holy Trinity – God, the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit – with us. God honors, and loves the Blessed Virgin Mary, because without her His plan of salvation would not have happened, and so we must do the same.

I also spoke about the intercessory power of a priest quoting Pope Benedict XVI: "The tradition of the Church viewed the story about Jacob's ladder, on which the angels ascended and descended, as an image of priestly life. The angels ascend and descend. This means that part of true friendship and fellowship with Christ is going up to Him and bringing the things of this world into His presence. But that automatically includes bringing down again what we have received from Him (Teaching and Learning the Love of God, p.107).

We are blessed to have Fr. Hayes offer the Masses here this weekend, the Solemnity of Corpus Christi. As a parish gift to him we have purchased the chasuble that he wore for his first Mass, and is wearing this weekend. I ask everyone to join my prayers for him at his first assignment as Associate Pastor at the parishes at Glencoe, Silver Lake, and Winsted. And that throughout his priesthood he will always draw everyone he encounters into a true friendship with the Holy Trinity, and that he may always give glory to the Father, Son, and the Holy Spirit. Amen.

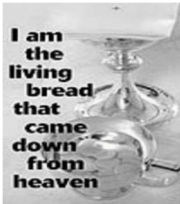
