**Chicken Take Out**

The Chicken Take Out is chaired by Brian and Renee Hartman. This is their second year doing this. Each year more and more people choose to either take home the Chicken meal or eat it out on the grounds, therefore making this a very important function. The ratio of take outs is rapidly approaching 50% of our total, which is well over 500 meals. So as you can imagine that's a lot of meals to package in such a short time. But through the hard work of the Hartman's and the other volunteers a wonderful job is done each year.

**Chicken Sales & Logistics**

Chicken Sales is an area that we are looking for a chair for again this year. Chicken sales involves packaging and selling the remaining chicken that does not get sold in the meal. This would begin around 1:00 PM or so and go until all the chicken is gone. In the past, we have had no problem getting rid of this chicken fast. We would love for someone to take over this area this year and possibly future years also.

Logistics is a relatively new area that is being chaired by Mike Sticha. There are many things that need to happen at the festival such as moving the chairs after church to the bingo area, keeping the bathrooms stocked with toilet paper, towels, soap etc., emptying the garbage cans, and other functions like this. Things that we really don't think about but need to get done!!

Please call Diana at 461-2817 if you are interested in taking over the Chicken sales. Again the festival is the main fundraiser for our Church and we need help from everybody to make it run smoothly. As you may have seen in the past highlight articles, MOST of our chairs have been doing their jobs for many years! This means many things – but here are just a few. One – we have WONDERFUL parishioners, who are willing to sacrifice their time to make this a great event. Two – it is very rewarding and can be fun to chair an event. Three – it makes our jobs way easier if we have good people that year in and year out continue to keep the festival running great!

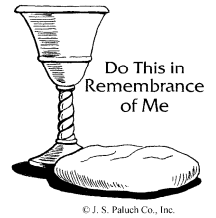
