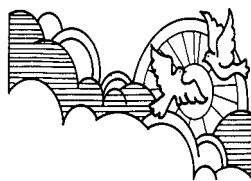

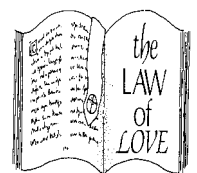

PARISH NURSE PROGRAM:

Hives are red, raised, and itchy welts that appear and disappear on your skin. Cells lining the blood vessels in our skin release certain chemicals, like histamine which can cause itching and swelling. Cool showers, cool compresses, or using an over-the-counter antihistamine may help relieve the discomfort. Tell your Dr. about the medications, including herbal supplements. He may ask for a list of possible irritants you may have been in contact with in the last 2-4 weeks, like foods, medications, and insect bites. A severe attack may require emergency care. BE WISE!
