Our festival has the best Children's Games around. Please help us keep up our reputation. If you have prizes to donate for Children's Games call Cathy Theis @ 952-461-2636.

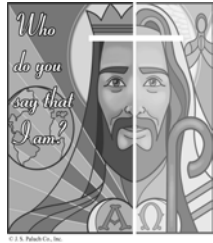
Festival Spotlight: CHILDREN'S GAMES

The Children's Games are an area that has grown substantially in the last 10 years with Cathy Theis and Dean & Chris Bisek chairing this area. We have gone from making very little money in Children's Games to averaging well over \$2000 of income each year. We have an awesome reputation for great games and great prizes and this is due to all the hard work and effort put in by the chairs. Each year we need over 2000 prizes for this area. The chairs spend many hours through the whole year looking for great deals to purchase all these toys at bargain prices to maximize our profits. The average expense each year is approximately \$1500. Prizes include toys of all sizes, stuffed animals, games, school supplies, candy and pop, and much more. We would like all parishioners to try to donate items for this area. The more we have donated the less our expense will be and the less time it will take for the chairs to shop for the 2000 prizes. If 50 parishioners each donate 20 items we would have half of the prizes done! But even if you can only donate 1 or 2 that is also great! Throughout the year just keep your eyes open for clearance items. It is amazing what you can find for 50-75% off when you look for it. There is a container in the back of church all year long where you can put your donated items. Another great thing about having such great Children's Games is that if the kids are happy the parents will stay longer and spend more money in all the other areas. So this helps out our overall festival profits! There is about a month left before the festival, so there still is plenty of time to get some great prizes. 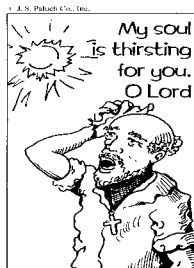

10 Things That Make for a Great Catholic Mom

6. Go Against the Grain (Joshua 24:15)

As unpopular as it may be, great Catholic moms know that sometimes we need to say "no" when everyday culture says "yes". Just because something is popular doesn't make it right or good for the growth of our children. Movies with graphic violence contribute to a culture of violence. Song lyrics that demean women or other races contradict the message of Christ to "love one another". Of course, kids are going to participate in the culture around them, but it is our job as parents to help mediate the meaning and value of that culture in the context of our Catholic Christian faith.

Do I have the courage to say "no" to something that I believe is not age-appropriate or good for my kids?

How might I seek out support and help with these decisions?
