## TEN THINGS THAT MAKE FOR A GREAT CATHOLIC DAD:

### **5. Play and Have Fun (Luke 18:16-17).**

A quote from Rabbi David Wolpe's book, *The Healer of Shattered Hearts*: "It doesn't have to be somber to be sacred." Many of us make the mistake of expecting our children to apply an adult's maturity and sophistication to our Faith, but one path to revealing the beauty of Catholicism is allowing kids to experience it on their terms. Using play, story, and song to allow Scripture and Tradition to unfold for the youngest of our flock is the foundation of children's Liturgy of the Word, Vacation Bible School, and religious education classes. When we read Bible stories to our kids, do character voices. When driving home from mass, re-sing the closing song (the upbeat ones, anyway). If we truly believe we are created in God's image, then certainly laughter and lightheartedness can enrich our faith as well.
