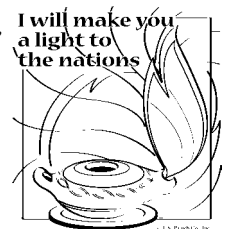

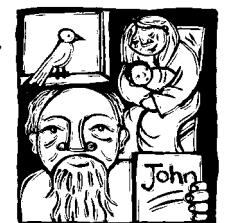

### Important Information Regarding the Protection of Youth and Children Initiative:

Parents, have you reminded your children about personal safety rules lately? With summer vacation here, now would be a great time to share these rules from the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children with your children.

#### **Knowing My Rules for Safety:**

1. I **CHECK FIRST** with my parents, guardians, or other trusted adults before going anywhere, doing anything, helping anyone, accepting anything, getting into a vehicle, or leaving with anyone.
1. I **TAKE A FRIEND** with me when going places or playing outside.
2. I **TELL** someone **NO** if they try to touch me or do things in ways that make me feel scared, uncomfortable, or confused, because it's **OK** for me to stand up for myself.
3. I **TELL** my parents, guardians, or other trusted adults if anything happens to me.

Sometimes there are people who choose to trick or hurt others. There is no excuse—no one has the right to force, trick, or pressure people into doing things they don't want to do. So use these rules, and remember . . .

#### **Nativity of John the Baptist, June 24**

The voice of the prophet had been silent, but in John the Baptist a tongue was loosened for the praise and glory of God. Though he came as a voiceless infant, he roared like a lion in the wilderness. Called from his mother's womb to be a light to the nations, John knew success and failure. Though he seemed to toil in vain, his reward was with the Lord.

When we look at John the Baptist, we see Christ mirrored in his life. Like Christ, he bore the reproaches of kings and suffered an ignominious death. Like Christ, John challenged people to repent of their sins. Though John's voice was like a sharp sword, Jesus was God's purifying Word of love and mercy. John was a lamp to show the way, but Jesus was the light of the world. John refused to point out his own greatness. Instead he knelt at the feet of the one he proclaimed. Although John was the greatest born of human birth, he is surpassed by the least born in God's kingdom. John challenges us to open our ears to his message and open our mouths to prepare the way of the Lord.

**For Reflection:** Do I see Christ when I look in the mirror? Do I know that I am called to be a prophetic voice in my community?
