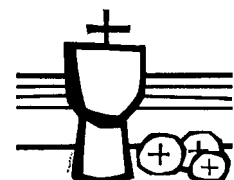

Looking for Volunteers. The volunteer themselves need to be 18 or older. The person they would provide respite to will be 60 plus years. They would be relieving the caregiver so that person could run errands, go to the beauty shop, have coffee with a friend, etc. The volunteer would do no hands on services, they would not be a home health aid. It's easiest to say they would be more like a friendly visitor; have coffee, play cards, reminisce about their past life, etc. The volunteer would provide safety and supervision while the caregiver is away.
