TEN THINGS THAT MAKE FOR A GREAT CATHOLIC DAD:

6. Get Caught Praying (Luke 11:1).

The Association of American Publishers has an ongoing campaign called "Get Caught Reading," in which celebrities and other well-known figures are photographed with their favorite books. Much the same kind of modeling can apply to prayer. Get "caught" praying, and pray with your children—over meals, at bedtime, anytime. Praying with someone is a pretty intimate act. In our house, we have a little outline we like to follow. We always start with prayers of gratitude, thanking God for our many blessings. Then, we move to asking for blessings for people we know and love, or for people who might need God's help. Finally, we can get into the nitty-gritty "gimmies": praying for good weather for field trips or for the strength and wisdom to do well in our work or at school. Doing so teaches our kids that we're all in an ongoing relationship and conversation with God. And that the conversation requires them to talk as well as to listen. *To be continued . . .*
