FROM THE PASTOR

Five years and counting.

This Wednesday, July 1, marks my fifth year anniversary as pastor of Saint Patrick's and Saint Catherine's. I have said it before and I will say it again, this is the best assignment I have ever had. That is not to disparage my other parishes but simply because these are so perfect for me, and I am back home. As I wrote to Archbishop Hebda when he offered Mass here on Trinity Sunday, "Everything about these parishes is wonderful: the locations, the churches, and especially the people." As my mom tells people, I am the happiest priest in the Archdiocese.



One of the things that I noticed immediately was the tremendous stewardship that our parishioners have for both of our parishes. For 14 years as a pastor before coming here, I constantly worried about money. I have not had to worry about that at all here. Even the special projects that we did: the steeple restoration at St. Patrick's, and the window project at St. Catherine's we're taken care of easily. Also our parishioners came through during this dark time of shut downs that we experienced.

The most important aspect of our parish is the spiritual realm. During these five years there have been 57 baptisms, 15 weddings, and 27 funerals. And of course, hundreds of Sunday and weekday Masses. All of these are ways that God touches us through His Word and the sacraments.

As I begin Year six I pray that God will bless the work that he has begun through me, make good its defects, and let me finish it in a way that is pleasing to Him - many years from now.

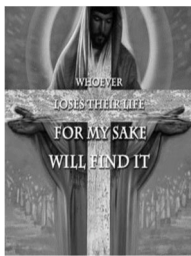
