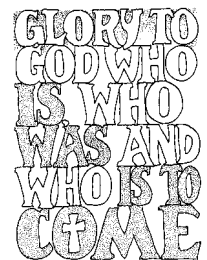

Holy Trinity, June 3

Trinity Sunday celebrates an event, not a doctrine: a person, not a precept. Paul says we can't explain God by human reason. It isn't a matter of creed or theology; it is a matter of faith and grace. We cannot reach the end of our discovery of God; each new level of understanding yields more mystery. We marvel at God's self-communication in the beauty of creation. The sun, moon, and stars, mountains and hills, fountains, springs and seas tell of the glory of God. Together we proclaim, "O Lord, how wonderful is your name in all the earth! Naming God as "Father, Son, and Spirit" only deepens our wonder.

Jesus reveals God simply by being one of us and one with us. Human experience teaches that God is with us in countless ways. Whether we are afflicted or blessed, we experience a God who loves us, heals us, and redeems us. When we look back on our lives and see the many ways that God was with us, we can begin to fathom the depths of divine wisdom and be at peace with God. Each trial is an opportunity to grow in our understanding of God who is with us so that we can be with God for all eternity.

For Reflection: In what ways have I encountered each person of the Trinity? Am I able to recognize Trinitarian love in my life?
