FESTIVAL BAKE DAY: Wednesday, June 30th at 8:00 AM. Also, volunteers needed for packaging at 6:00 PM the same day.

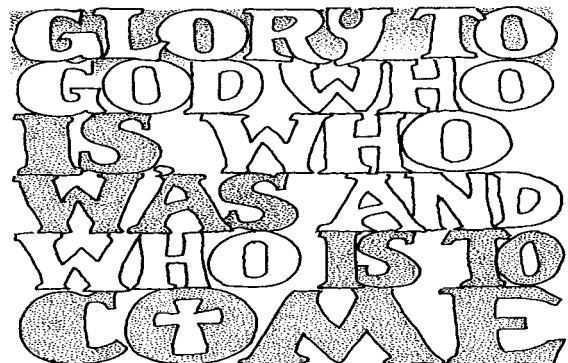
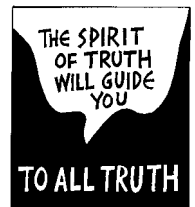

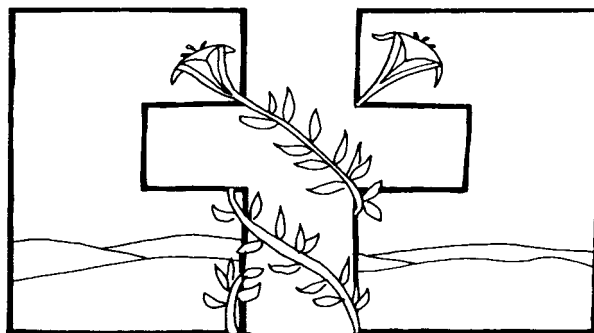
*Our parish community is saddened by the death of Anna Sandey. We offer our prayers and sympathy to her family and friends.
