This week we celebrate the reality that makes the exchange of God's love possible: the Body and Blood of Christ. God's plan from the beginning was for us to share His life. When that gift was rejected through sin, God's plan of reconciliation was put in motion. It culminated in the sacrifice of the Body and Blood of Jesus on the cross, and His resurrection after this sacrifice.
