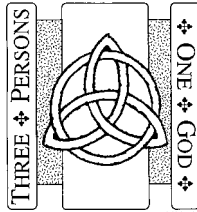

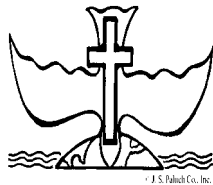

### TEN THINGS THAT MAKE FOR A GREAT CATHOLIC DAD:

#### 3. Don't Forget Forgiveness (Matthew 18:21-22).

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is a uniquely Catholic ritual. Few other traditions require that sinners confess sins aloud. In this way, Catholicism teaches accountability as well as reminding us of God's bottomless well of forgiveness—great lessons to teach our kids. But it's easy to leave those values at the confessional. As Catholic fathers, we have an added responsibility. The accountability our Faith has taught us requires us to admit to our children when we are wrong, ask their forgiveness when we mess up, and show them that we and their mothers forgive, and ask forgiveness of, each other all the time. This reminds them—as God reminds us—that mistakes are allowed. They are fully human and fully expected as part of our faith journey. *To be continued...*
