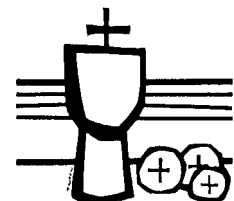

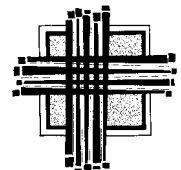

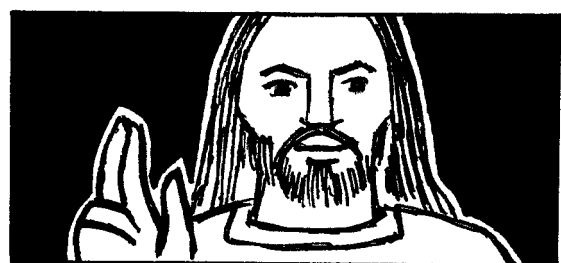

PARISH NURSE PROGRAM: Visits from grandchildren this summer? Remember these safety tips:

*Don't use the microwave to heat up formulas and foods. It may burn their throats.

*Place babies on their BACKS on a firm mattress removing pillows, quilts, and stuffed toys. Studies show a dramatic decrease in deaths from Sudden Infant Death Syndrome (SIDS).

*Know how to remove the child from a car seat or booster chair. Remember no child should be seated in the front seat, if you have an airbag.

*Video games: select games that promote problem solving, set limits, and play "with" them. Use the E.S.R.B. ratings listed on the box. E=everyone-6+, T=teens, M=adults.

*Be a good listener, especially for your teens. Accept them for who they are and show them you are genuinely concerned about them. *Grandchildren are special gifts. Enjoy them and be safe in caring for them.*
