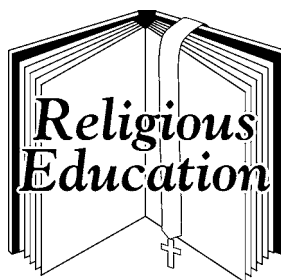
**A CORDIAL WELCOME TO ALL:** If you are a visitor you are invited to sign the welcome book in the entry way and come and worship with us again.

**10. Laugh!** (Proverbs 17:22)  
In the Old Testament, when Sarah gives birth to Isaac at a very advanced age, she says, "God has brought laughter for me; everyone who hears will laugh with me" (Gen 21:6). Even the ancients knew that motherhood would be filled with laughter. There is no greater joy than laughing with our children. Laughter is also a great stress reliever.
