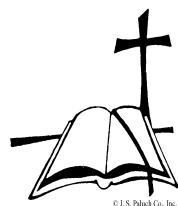

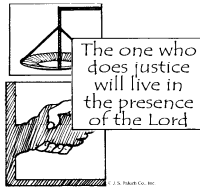

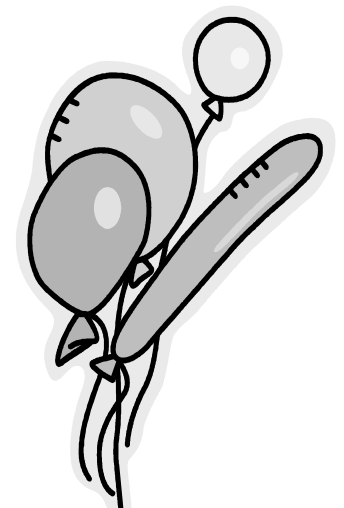

“Pro-woman, Pro-man, Pro-child”, Celebrate and reverence God’s vision of human sexuality, discover Natural Family Planning is the theme of this year’s Natural Family Planning Awareness Week, a national educational campaign of the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) to celebrate God’s vision for marriage and promote the methods of Natural Family Planning.

Natural Family Planning (NFP) is an umbrella term for the safe, natural, and effective methods of both achieving and avoiding pregnancy. NFP methods teach couples how to observe and interpret the woman’s signs of fertility and infertility. In the words of the *Catechism of the Catholic Church*, NFP methods “respect the bodies of the spouses, encourage tenderness between them and favor the education of an authentic freedom.”
