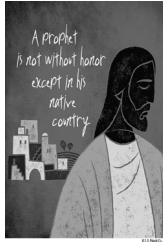
DISH TOWELS are available in the box in the back of church for embroidering for our church festival to be sold at the Country Store. Please sign the notebook and how many you are taking.
