FROM THE PASTOR

Catholic Church in China



Fr. Doug Mullin, OSB will be preaching a mission appeal at all St. Patrick and St. Catherine Masses during the weekend of July 7-8. He is a monk and priest of Saint John's Abbey, and the vice president for student development at Saint John's University (both in Collegeville, MN). Fr. Doug also serves on the board of directors for the U.S.-China Catholic Association (USCCA), and will speak to us on their behalf. The USCCA offers services, as well as educational and cultural programs that build bridges of friendship in support of the Catholic Church in China. Fr. Doug works with priests and sisters from China who are doing graduate studies at Saint John's School of Theology and Seminary, and he has traveled to China a number of times. He will share important information and stories about the good work and challenges of the Catholic Church in China. A second collection will be taken on behalf of the USCCA.

Funds used by the U.S. Catholic China Bureau will be

1. Applied to produce and distribute information to American Catholics who are tourists or business people to China and seek to attend a local Catholic church in a specific diocese to which they will travel.
2. On a case by case basis, offer financial support by responding to requests to Chinese Catholic priests in Sisters in China for specific projects of need/ evangelization. Given current Chinese law, this is done in a low key manner with little publicity when various friends of the China Bureau travel to China. This process fulfills our mission to establish bridge building and friendship.
3. Building on the success of our 2017 China Study Tour contributions assist us to make public and meet potential people interested in participating in the upcoming 2018 and 2019 summer study tour.
4. Organize and plan our 2019 National conference.
5. Respond where needed to requests made by Chinese Catholic parishes in the United States.
6. Network a response to Chinese students matriculated in U.S. Catholic universities and high schools.

As we continue to move forward with our Capital Campaign, it was decided to contact Gaytee Palmer Glass Company and get on their schedule. I discussed this with Al Palmer, and he has given us a start date of Monday, July 9th. Weather permitting, he estimates it will take them 10 days to 2 weeks to complete. I also informed him of our upcoming Garden Tour, July 28th, and the need to be done by then. We will monitor this very carefully. We would suggest doing the 2 front windows first, followed by the 4 windows on the East, parking lot side, then the remaining 4 windows on the West side to complete the project. *Joe Williamson*
