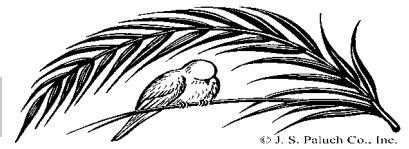


First Reading: Jeremiah 38:4-6, 8-10

19th Sunday in Ordinary Time—August 12

If Abraham, the great "father of faith," was tested, we can expect that we will be tested. The stories of Scripture are our stories. Throughout salvation history the people of God walked by faith with confident assurance in things unseen. When Abraham was called, he went forth without knowing where he was going. Like Abraham, we must continue on the journey with its trials and hardships.

Often, the journey is too hard, and the rewards are too few. As Jesus' disciples we must not live in fear but in faith that what we are seeking is not in vain. God has prepared a place for us, "an unfailing treasure in heaven" a homeland whose builder is our God.

In the meantime, we must prepare a place for God. Are we diligently at work building God's kingdom? Or are we slothful servants who abuse one another? Like the great people of faith, we must have our belts fastened and our lamps burning, ready to greet the master who will lead us to our heavenly home.

For Reflection: Do I have confident assurance of God's loving kindness on my journey of faith? Am I a just steward of God's household as I await the coming of God's reign?
