GET WHAT YOU GIVE

He who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and he who sows bountifully will also reap bountifully.

It stands to reason that the bigger the investment, the bigger the opportunity to gain.

Another way of saying it: You get out of something in proportion to what you put in. Think about it. How much do you put in your envelope each Sunday? The specific amount isn't important. Do you give a dollar or two because it's easy to give? Or do you give a meaningful, significant amount?

The next question: What do you expect to get in return for what you give? You may think you shouldn't expect anything; after all, you don't make deals with Almighty God. But can we ignore our Lord's own words: "Give and it shall be given to you." And it would follow that the more you give, the more will be given to you. Try it. See if it's possible to out-do God in generosity.
