PARISH NURSE PROGRAM:

Diet of a child can directly affect the behavior and learning capabilities. The quick and easy brightly colored cereal, certain pops or candy are filled with food dyes made from petroleum & flavorings made from synthetic chemicals which can set off a sensitive child. If your child appears more fidgety, has difficulty concentrating, or may be impulsive, step back and look at his diet for the day. Boredom, the care-setting, may also be an area to look at. Make some changes, if needed. If you see no improvement, you may want to have him checked by your doctor to rule out physical problems, like thyroid problem.
