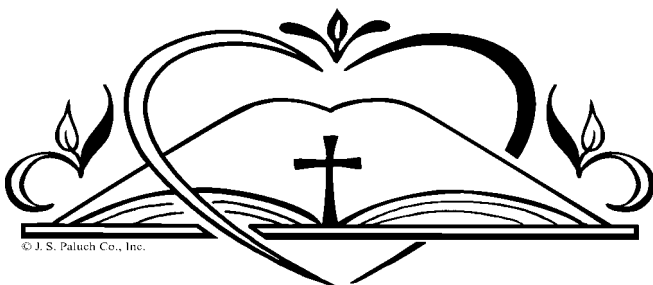

**22nd Sunday in Ordinary Time, August 31**

Jeremiah complained to God that he was too young to be a prophet. No matter how much he struggled to avoid the responsibility, God said, "I'm sending you!" Jeremiah had a difficult task because violence and outrage were his message. When all he got in return was scorn and derision, Jeremiah was ready to give up. Yet God's word became like a fire burning in his heart. No matter what price he was asked to pay, Jeremiah had to speak.

Paul knew the high cost of serving God—imprisonment, sickness, loneliness, beatings, and shipwreck. Still, his sacrifice couldn't compare with the price Jesus paid on Calvary. Peter tried to stand in Jesus' way when he faced the cross. He allowed himself to be conformed to the world's values, not God's. If Peter wanted to follow Jesus, he needed to get behind him and share his cross.

Like Jeremiah, Peter, and Paul, we must be willing to give up power, prestige, and possessions if they prevent our serving God. We must do our best to present ourselves as holy and acceptable offerings to God.

**For Reflection:** What challenge does sacrifice present to me? How has it helped me grow in my Christian service?
