10 Simple Ways to be a Christian Steward:

1. **Visit** an elderly neighbor or friend on a regular basis.
2. **Do** one good deed each week that will benefit someone else without their knowledge.
3. **Share** a meal you've prepared with a homebound person.
4. **Thank** people whose work usually goes unnoticed.
5. **Volunteer** for tasks at your parish, such as hospitality, ushering, or caring for children.
6. **Donate** regularly to your local food shelf.
7. **Turn off** lights and appliances when you leave a room.
8. **Carpool** whenever possible.
9. **Use** only as much water that is necessary to complete tasks like brushing teeth, bathing, and washing dishes, etc.
10. **Clean** your family's closets and donate items that have not been worn during the past year.

Who is a Christian Steward?

There is a difference between stewardship based on duty and stewardship based on love. When stewardship flows from our love for the Lord, it involves the joyful giving of time, talent, and treasure. The giving, in turn, results in a higher level of happiness and satisfaction in the steward.

When we give joyfully through love, we take pleasure in the quality of our gift. When we truly love, we also take pleasure in the quality of the gifts given by others to those we love—even though those gifts may be lesser or more than ours.

- **How can we learn to give joyfully and to take pleasure in the gifts of others?**
- **How can we encourage others to give joyfully out of love?**

It is critical that all people recognize they have unique gifts. It is also important to recognize that others have different gifts.

Our individual gifts and talents have been given to us by God for the purpose of building up the Church.
