Justice—the “play fair” virtue

One of the first lessons we learn as children is to ‘play fair’ and share our toys and treats. Fairness or justice is the bottom line of our Christian duty to our neighbor. It’s clear and easy to understand . . . even for kids.

Goods and property are where justice starts. It’s unjust to take what belongs to someone else. (That’s stealing.) And, it’s unjust to fail to give others what we owe them. (Agree to rent a parking space and you have to pay the rent.)

When it’s our job to distribute or share something good, it’s not right to take more for ourselves than we give to others. And when we’re distributing something unpleasant like a hard or dirty job, it’s unjust to give more of such responsibility to others than we take for ourselves.

But, what’s “fair” is only the most basic ingredient of what’s right. Jesus tells us we need to add love, mercy, and forgiveness to complete his recipe for how to live.
