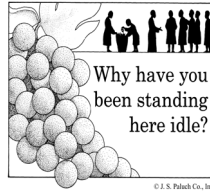

Sept. 2, 2014 Message from Our Lady of Medjugorje:
 "Dear children, I, your Mother, am coming anew among you out of love which has no end, from endless love of the endless Heavenly Father.
